Sec. 10.230. Dead animals.

The owner of any animal which may die within the city, shall, within twenty-four (24) hours after its death, remove and bury the same outside the city limits. In case any person shall fail to comply with the provisions of this section and shall fail to remove any dead animal belonging to him, the chief of police shall make such disposal of the same as the law directs, and the costs of such disposal shall be recovered of such owner by action before the magistrate, with costs of suit. It shall be the duty of the chief of police to remove all dead animals at the cost of the city when the owner is unknown or refuses or fails to comply with this provision, and to prosecute all persons violating this section. ARTICLE III. FLUORIDATION

Sec. 10.301. City water fluoridated.

(a) A source of fluoride ion, approved by the Alaska Department of Health, shall be added to the water supply of the City of Fairbanks, under the rules and regulations of the Alaska Department of Health, such addition to be administered by the municipal utilities system in a manner approved by the health officer of the city.

(b) The municipal utilities system of the city is hereby authorized and directed to prepare the necessary plans and specifications which shall be submitted to the state board of health for approval and then to proceed with the necessary work to accomplish the purposes specified in subsection (a).

ARTICLE IV. ABANDONED ICEBOXES

Sec. 10.401. Prohibiting abandonment in places accessible to children.

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to leave or permit to remain outside of any dwelling, building or
